CPF national *concours d'art oratoire* 2012 scholarship descriptions.



CPF Canadian Parents for French

Recipients of all scholarships must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents. Students must be registered full-time in a regular undergraduate program at the University of Ottawa. Students who win scholarships but are not eligible to attend university in the 2012-2013 academic year will have their scholarships held in reserve.

Grand Prize Scholarships

Number: 5 (1 per category)
Value: \$20,000 (\$5,000 per year)

Requirements

Take at least 3 courses (nine credits) taught in French per semester.

Renewal criteria

These scholarships may be awarded for four years provided that the award holder obtains and maintains a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 8.5 or higher and is registered full-time and takes at least 3 courses (nine credits) taught in French per semester.

Recipients who do not meet the renewal criteria described above in any given year will be able to renew their Admission Scholarship if their CGPA is between 8.0 and 8.4 or increases to 8.0. It will be renewed at a minimum of \$2,000. Moreover, recipients who increase their CGPA to 8.5 in subsequent years will be able to renew this scholarship at the full amount.

Notes

The first installment of the scholarship must be used during the recipient's first year of university.

This scholarship cannot be combined with the Renewable Admission Scholarship, the French Studies Bursary, the President's Scholarship or the Chancellor's Scholarship.

Second Place Scholarships

Number: 5 (1 per category)
Value: \$5,000

Requirements

Take at least 2 courses (six credits) taught in French per semester.

Notes

The scholarship must be used during the recipient's first year of university. The amount is not renewable. In subsequent years, a student's Renewable Admission Scholarship can be activated at an amount based on his or her high school academic average.

It may be combined with the French Studies Bursary (worth \$1,000), but it cannot be combined with the Renewable Admission Scholarship, the President's Scholarship, or the Chancellor's Scholarship.

Participants Scholarship

Number: All remaining participants
Value: \$2,000

Notes

The scholarship must be used during the recipient's first year of university. The amount is not renewable. In subsequent years, a student's Renewable Admission Scholarship can be activated at an amount based on their high school academic average. This scholarship can be combined with the French Students Bursary (worth \$1,000).
