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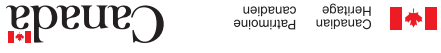

travel.

To make arrangements for travel to Ottawa please call Michel Dore at Voyages Rideau Travel (as soon as you have faxed in your registration forms) at: 1.800.265.9562, and request a return ticket by plane to Ottawa to participate in CPF's National Concours.

All travel arrangements are *final*. The cost of flights is non-refundable; therefore, please note you will be responsible for covering the costs of any travel changes. If you live within driving distance you are expected to participate in all activities, including staying overnight on campus.

accommodations.

Friday and Saturday night accommodations will be in shared rooms at the University of Ottawa residence. CPF will make the arrangements. For emergency purposes a student staying at the University may be reached by calling: 613.564.5400.

If you are arriving earlier than Friday, May 25 or staying after Sunday, May 27 and require a room you will be responsible for that cost, and *must provide CPF, in writing and prior to the event, a permission form signed by a parent or guardian*. Please see the *leave form* for further details.

You are responsible for your incidentals (e.g. phone calls, parking, snacks). FYI - Check-out time is Sunday at noon.
